Evidence-based practice in neuropsychology: What constitutes "evidence"?

Jane Holmes Bernstein, Ph.D. is a Senior Associate in Psychology/Neuropsychology at Children's Hospital Boston and on the faculty of the Department of Psychiatry at Harvard Medical School. After many years as director of the Neuropsychology Program at the Children's Hospital, she is currently dividing her time between responsibilities at TCH and establishing the National Child Development Programme in the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago in the West Indies. Her work has focused on models of developmental neuropsychology, and the training of clinicians from this perspective.

Dr. Bernstein received her Ph.D. in Linguistics from Edinburgh University in Scotland. She worked at the Churchill and Park Hospitals in Oxford, completed a postdoctoral fellowship in the Aphasia Research Center at the Boston Veterans Administration Medical Center, and subsequently joined the staff of the Children's Hospital Boston. She was a founding member of the Massachusetts Neuropsychological Society where she has served on the Board and as president. She is a Fellow of the National Academy of Neuropsychology, the American Psychological Association and the Massachusetts Psychological Association, and has been a Faculty Fellow of the Mind/Brain/Behavior Initiative of Harvard University. She has worked as Associate (Clinical) Director of the NIH-funded Learning Disabilities Research Center at TCH with Principal Investigator Dr. Deborah Waber.
